

Your recycling bin

What you can and can't recycle

Glass bottles and jars

- ✓ lids and labels are OK
- ✗ no mirror glass, drinking glasses or Pyrex



Plastic bottles, tubs and containers

- ✓ ensure bottles are empty
- ✓ keep lids on
- ✗ no soft plastics, polystyrene or plastic bags



Steel cans, aerosols and cookware

- ✓ no need to clean food tins, just ensure all food scraps are removed



Aluminium cans and foil

- ✓ scrunch used foil for recycling



Paper, cardboard and cartons

- ✓ flatten cardboard boxes
- ✗ no take away coffee cups, tissues, serviettes or paper towel
- ✗ no waxed cardboard



Remember not to bag your recycling!

Council no longer accepts soft plastics, such as cling wrap or plastic bags. For more information visit Council's website.

Do not put in your recycling bin:

- ✗ Garbage
- ✗ Clothing, shoes or blankets
- ✗ Food waste or garden waste
- ✗ Nappies
- ✗ Polystyrene
- ✗ Napkins, tissues or paper towel
- ✗ Toys
- ✗ Drinking glasses, ceramics or Pyrex
- ✗ Soft plastics (take these to Coles or Woolworths for recycling)

If you put items which are not acceptable for recycling in your recycling bin, your bin may not be collected until the contaminants have been removed.
