



The Albion Off-Street Route:

- Is a 950m concrete shared path running from Sydney Road to Lygon Street on the north side of Albion Street;
- Vehicles on the road network have priority over Albion Street shared path users.

Role of the Albion Off-Street Route within the bicycle network

This path operates as a wide footpath on which cycling is permitted.

In the short term, the Albion Off-Street Route has become part of the Brunswick Shimmy, with upgraded bicycle lanes proposed for Barrow Street and back routes east of Lygon Street.

In the longer term, upgrades to the on-road network may provide an on-road link to the Upfield Shared Path, and a possible extension further west.

Albion Street includes bridges over Citylink and Moonee Ponds Creek, and provides a direct link to Essendon. Upgrades to the on-road network could significantly improve links between activity areas in Moreland and Moonee Valley.

Improvements to Albion Off-Street Route

This facility is now better linked into the cycling network through the East Brunswick Shimmy project. Opportunities to improve linkages to the west of this route will be investigated.
