



The Boundary Road on-road route:

- Is a 2.3 km bicycle lane running between Sydney Road (Hume Highway) and West Street, Hadfield, on a VicRoads controlled road;
- Is not subject to any on-road parking controls, and cyclists often experience difficulty using the bike lanes due to the presence of parked cars.

Role of the Boundary Road on-road route within the bicycle network

This route provides a link between the Glenroy to Coburg East West route, and the Upfield Shared Path to residents of Pascoe Vale and Hadfield. The route also provides a link between Glenroy and Fawkner.

Improvements to Boundary Road on-road route

Council will advocate to VicRoads to upgrade this cycling route.
