Application form

Moreland City Council's Kindergarten Central Enrolment Scheme provides families with an easy and fair process to apply for sessional 3-year-old kindergarten programs on behalf of 25 participating kindergartens located in Moreland. Council does not manage kindergartens and has an agreement with these kindergartens to accept and process applications for them. Some kindergartens are managed by an Early Years Manager or Committee of Management. A list of participating kindergartens can be found in this application form.

Applications are open from Tuesday 1 March 2022 until Friday 9 December 2022.

Note: If you apply after 9 December, please contact our office to check if kindergarten places are still available. Kindergartens close Tuesday 20 December 2022 for the school holidays.

Sessional kindergarten

Three-year-old sessional kindergarten is an educational, play-based learning program delivered by a degree qualified Kindergarten teacher. The Victorian State Government through the Department of Education and Training (DET) fund 3-year-old kindergartens to operate for 5 hours per week. This funding goes directly to the Kindergarten or the Early Years Manager to help them with the costs of running the program. **Note:** This funding does not go to the child or the parent.

Sessional Kindergartens provide a kindergarten program throughout the school terms, where children are given the opportunity to develop their independence, confidence, social and emotional skills, supported by the 5 Learning Outcomes in the Victorian Early Years Learning and Development Framework.

Please read the following information about enrolling your child for 3-year-old kindergarten:

- Children must turn 3 years of age by 30 April 2023
- Children can only attend 3-year-old kindergarten once they have turned 3 years of age.
- Children can only attend **ONE** funded 3-year-old kindergarten program. This means your child cannot attend another kindergarten or child care centre that offers a funded 3-year-old kindergarten program.
- Children cannot attend two years of 3-year-old kindergarten

Kindergarten program hours and fees

Three-year-old Kindergarten hours and fees are set by each kindergarten or their Early Years Manager. Some kindergartens will offer 5 hours per week, other kindergartens may offer longer hours. The cost may vary depending on the program hours. Families are advised to contact their preferred kindergarten to discuss their fee policy and session times. If you or your child hold a fee subsidy card or visa document, please check with the kindergarten what the fees will be. A list of the subsidy cards that the State Government supports can be found in this application form.

Immunisation

Before your child can start kindergarten, you will need to give the Kindergarten or their Early Years Manager evidence that your child is:

- Fully immunised for their age by providing a copy of your child's **up-to-date Australian Immunisation History Statement**
- On a vaccination catch-up program or
- Unable to be fully immunised for medical reasons

You can print a copy of your child's Australian Immunisation History Statement from your myGov account. If you have difficulty getting a copy, please call the Australian Immunisation Register (AIR) on 1800 653 809 or visit a Medicare or Centrelink office.

Please Note: Families who do not hold a Medicare card must call the Australian Immunisation Register to request an Immunisation History Statement. A Translating and Interpreting Service is available by calling 131 450 Monday to Friday from 8:30am to 4:45pm.

Priority of access

The Victorian Government has Priority of Access guidelines to allocate 3-year-old kindergarten places which all kindergartens must follow. Kindergarten places prioritise the following children: **Note:** If the kindergarten is full, your child's name will be placed on the list as a priority until a place becomes available.

- Children who are Aboriginal and/or Torres Strait Islander
- Children with additional needs
- Children known to Child Protection or in an Out of Home Care arrangement
- Children of refugee or asylum seeker status

How are kindergarten places allocated?

Moreland City Council's Central Enrolment Scheme has designed a points system to allocate kindergarten places.

Applications received between 1 March and 31 May will be prioritised based on a points and proximity system.

During this time period, the date you submit your application does not affect priority of preference.

Note: All applications received from 1 June do not receive points. These applications will be processed in date of received order only.

Can I complete this form?

- YES, if your child was born between 1 January 2018 to 30 April 2019 and is not attending a 3-year-old kindergarten program at another Kindergarten or Child Care Centre.
- Applications will only be accepted for children turning 3 years of age by 30 April 2023.
- Note: Do not complete this form if your child is attending a 3-year-old kindergarten program in 2022. Please contact our office for further information.

Application requirements and supporting documents

- Complete a separate application form for each child you are enrolling.
- A copy of your child's proof of age document is required. Note: Only attach one document for example:
 - Birth Certificate
 - Passport
 - copy of your child's Australian Immunisation History Statement (you can get this document from Medicare or your myGov account)
 - or Immigration document
- If you live or pay rates in Moreland proof of your address is required.

Please provide **only one document** listed below as a proof with the application form. This document is to be dated within the **past 12 months**, must have your name and address details included. **Note:** A P.O. Box address or business name will not be accepted

- Rates notice
- Utilities bill (gas/water/electricity)
- Driver's licence
- Property rental lease agreement
- If you are a non-resident of Moreland with a link to Moreland (see below) please provide proof of evidence for the following:
 - If you work or study in Moreland provide a letter of proof from your employer or educational institution
 - If you have a child who attends a school or child care centre in Moreland provide a fee invoice or letter as proof.

Please Note: If the child care provider is not a registered business, they will need to complete a Statutory Declaration form. This form needs to include the child care provider's name, address and contact details and the name of the child that is being cared for. A PO Box number will not be accepted.

• There is a **non-refundable** application fee of **\$25** for each child. This is an administration fee and is not part of your Kindergarten fees. All cheques are to made payable to **MORELAND CITY COUNCIL**.

What happens after I submit this Application form?

- Your application will be processed within **four weeks** of receipt. You will receive an **acknowledgement email or letter** confirming we have received your application form.
- If there are errors in your acknowledgement email or letter, or you have not received any communication from Moreland City Council within five weeks of applying, please contact the Kindergarten Central Enrolment Officer.

When will offers take place?

This application form for the Moreland Central Enrolment Scheme does not guarantee your child a kindergarten place. Moreland City Council does not manage kindergartens. Council has an agreement to accept and process applications on behalf of Kindergartens/Early Years Managers. The Kindergarten or their Early Years Manager will let Council know how many places can be offered to families.

Applications received:	Expect an email or letter:
Between 1 March and 31 May 2022	By the end of August. An email or letter will be sent to parent/guardian 1 who is listed in the application, offering your child a place or informing you that your child is on a waiting list.
From 1 June 2022	From September onwards. An email or letter will be sent to parent/guardian 1 who is listed in the application offering your child a place or informing you that your child is on a waiting list.

Please Note: If you are offered a place, you have 7 days to accept and respond.

What happens after you accept a place?

- Within four weeks of accepting a place, you will be sent an email or letter, confirming your child's place at your selected kindergarten.
- In September the Kindergarten or the Early Years Manager will be notified of your child's attendance for 2023.
- The Kindergarten or the Early Years Manager will contact you before the end of December with information about the session times and fees.

What happens if my child does not get offered a place?

- If the kindergarten you have chosen is full, your child's name will be placed on the waiting list. You will receive an email or letter advising this. If you choose to leave your child's name on the list, you will be notified once a place becomes available.
- If you wish to change to a different kindergarten, please contact our office to see which kindergartens are available.

Please Note: If you change to a new kindergarten preference, you will be unable to leave your child's name on a kindergarten's waiting list.
