New playspace: new equipment including a basket swing, combination unit with monkey bars and climbing elements will complement existing equipment being refurbished, together with nature play including rocks and logs for stepping, clambering and balancing.

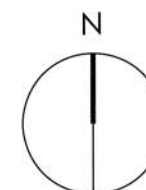
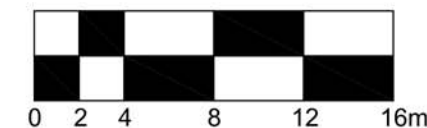
Basketball half-court is proposed to be located in an area near the sports ground. Together with the new playspace this will provide a great variety of play for a broad range of age groups. This is subject to extra funding being available.

Planting of more trees for shade in picnic and play areas as well as new garden beds to increase amenity and habitat value.

New park furniture including picnic setting, park seat and platform bench. A picnic shelter with barbecue is also proposed which is subject to extra funding being available.

Council has allocated funds in the current financial year for a range of improvements in this local reserve and is inviting community feedback on what is proposed. As shown in the plan above these include a re-designed playspace and picnic shelter with BBQ. With a new fence located nearer the property boundary on Moore Street to increase the available park space, a basketball half court is also proposed.
